Eco-friendly knitted DISHCLOTHS - knit or crochet (4 easy patterns)

Materials:

4mm or 4.5mm single pointed knitting needles OR crochet hook Cotton yarn (100g)
Large eye sewing needle
Stitch markers (optional)

Instructions:

Pattern 1 Garter Stitch (Knit every row):

Cast on 46 sts.

Knit every row until your work is square or the desired length.

Pattern 2 Stocking Stitch (Knit first row, Purl second row):

Cast on 46 sts. Knit 6 rows.

Start the 2 row repeat pattern:

Row 1 (RS): Knit 6 Stitches (place marker) Knit to last 6 stitches (place marker) Knit 6 stitches

Row 2 (WS): Knit 6 stitches (slip marker) Purl to last 6 stitches (slip marker) Knit 6 stitches

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 (slip the markers as you go) until your work is square or the desired length.

Knit 6 Rows Cast off



Cast on 46 stitches and knit 6 rows

Start the 2 row repeat pattern

Row 1 (RS): Knit 6 stitches (place marker) Knit 1 Purl 1 repeat to last 6 stitches (place marker) Knit 6 stitches Row 2 (WS): Knit 6 stitches (slip marker) Purl 1 Knit 1 repeat to last 6 stitches (slip marker) Knit 6 stitches Repeat Rows 1 and 2 (slip the markers as you go) until your work is square or the desired length.

Knit 6 Rows Cast off

Pattern 4 Crochet:

Abbreviations:

sl st = slip stitch

ch = chain

sp = space

htr = half treble

dc = double crochet

Instructions:

With 4.4mm or 5mm hook chain 41

Row 1: dc in third ch from hook (ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch) across. Turn

Row 2: 2 ch, htr in first ch sp (ch1,skip next dc, htr in next ch sp) repeat to end. Turn

Row 3: ch1, dc in first ch sp (ch 1, skip next htr, dc in next ch sp) repeat to end. Turn

Repeat rows 2 & 3 until your work is square or the desired length ending with a dc row, Border

Ch 1, Turn, Dc in same space as ch, ch2, dc in same corner sp.

Dc 2 rows evenly around edge of dishcloth working (dc in corner space, ch2, dc in same space) at each corner. Join with sl st in first dc. Fasten off.
