## Knit and Crochet Flowers

## CROCHET FLOWER

## Materials

DK yarn: small amounts of two colours of own choice with a 4 mm crochet hook (smaller flower)
OR
Chunky or $2 \times$ DK yarn: small amounts of two colours of own choice with a 6 mm crochet hook (larger flower)
Large eye sewing needle

## Abbreviations

ch = chain
tr = treble crochet
ss = slip stitch
sts $=$ stitches

## Instructions

In red, white or blue, make slip knot and chain 4.
Slip stitch into 1st ch to make a ring (or make a magic ring).
Round 1: Ch3 (represents one treble) and work 8 treble crochet into the ring. Slip Stitch to join in top ch of starting 3 ch. (9 stitches)

Round 2: With contrasting yarn (red, white or blue), join in any stitch and make 3ch and 2 tr into the same stitch. 3tr into each of the following 8 stitches in the round. SS to top of first 3 ch to join. (27 sts)

Round 3: 3ch and 2tr into the same stitch. 3tr into each of the following 26 stitches in the round. SS to top of first 3 ch to join. (81 sts). Fasten off and sew in yarn ends.


## SEDGLEY E

## KNITTED FLOWER

## Materials

DK yarn: small amounts of two colours of own choice.
3.75 mm (old size 9) or knitting needles

Large eye sewing needle

## Instructions

All worked in garter stitch (every row knit).
Using red, white or blue yarn, cast on 80 stitches.
Rows 1-6: Knit to end (for a larger flower, 2 or 4 extra rows can be added at this point)

Row 7: Knit 2 together to end (40 stitches)
Row 8: Knit to end
Row 9: Knit 2 together to end (20 stitches)
Row 10: Knit to end
Row 11: Knit 2 together to end (10 stitches)
Row 12: Knit to end
Row 13: Knit 2 together to end (5 stitches)
Row 14: Knit to end
Cut yarn leaving a long tail.
Using a large eye needle, thread yarn through remaining 5 stitches and pull tight and secure with stitches. Use remaining yarn to stitch row ends together and fasten off.

## Flower Centre

EITHER Cast on 1 stitch using contrasting colour (red, white or blue). Knit into back and front of stitch until 5 stitches created. Knit 7 rows. Cut yarn leaving a long tail.

Thread yarn through 5 stitches, pull tight and secure with stitches. Sew in place in centre of flower.
OR Find a button in contrasting colour (red, white or blue) and sew in place in centre of flower.
