Jenny Thorne will teach you how to do Stump Work embroidery

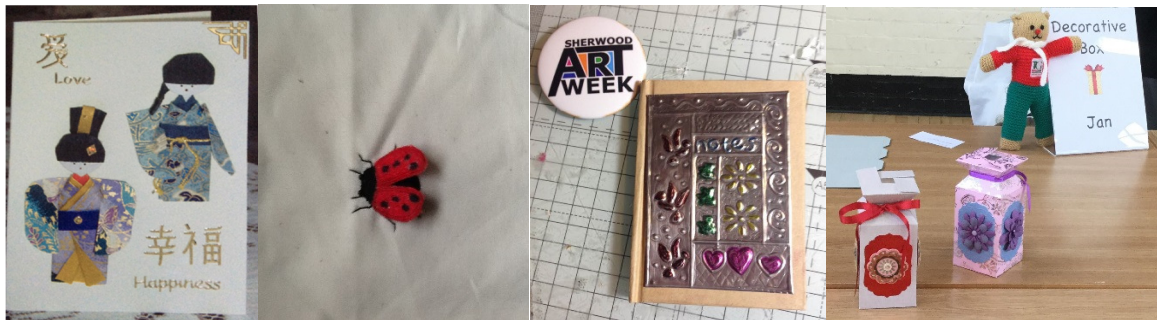
Beryl Hales will help you to learn how to do pewter work
